About the Event:

The Red Bandanna Classic is a charity golf tournament honoring Welles Crowther, a 9/11 civilian hero. The Classic raises funds to support the work of the Welles Remy Crowther Charitable Trust by bringing family, friends and others touched by Welles' story together to remember Welles, have fun and hit a few golf balls.

Welles Crowther was a 1995 graduate of Nyack High School and a high honor roll student for 4 years. He played varsity lacrosse, soccer, and was ice hockey captain for the Indians. He was a 1999 graduate of Boston College and played 4 years of varsity lacrosse for the Eagles. Welles was an equities trader for Sandler O'Neill & Partners in the World Trade Center. He was also a fully trained volunteer firefighter, a member of Empire Hook and Ladder Co., No. 1, in Upper Nyack, New York. On September 11th when the attacks on the World Trade Center began, Welles was no longer an equities trader. He became a firefighter.

Months after September 11th, Welles' heroic acts came to light. Welles used the last hour of his life to save others. He wore his red bandanna, one which he always kept in his back pocket, to cover his nose and mouth as protection against smoke and dust while he carried and directed others to safety. Welles is remembered now around the world as "The Man in the Red Bandanna"; his story inspiring many people of all ages, backgrounds and nationalities.

The Welles Remy Crowther Charitable Trust was established by the Crowther family to honor their son's memory through good works. The mission of the trust is to help young people become exemplary adults through education, health, character development and recreation. Scholarships have been established in Rockland County, as well as annual or major gifts to organizations such as Bonnie Brae, Institute for Educational Achievement, Cristo Rey NY High School, Children of Bellevue, Nyack Hospital, the Smile Train, Fresh Air Fund, MetroLacrosse, C.O.R.S.E. Therapeutic Riding Program, Dana Farber Cancer Institute, the Wild Center, HSLAPS, Just One Soccer League, MusicWorks, Rockland Conservatory of Music, Rockland Symphony Young People's Concert and the YMCA of Rockland.
